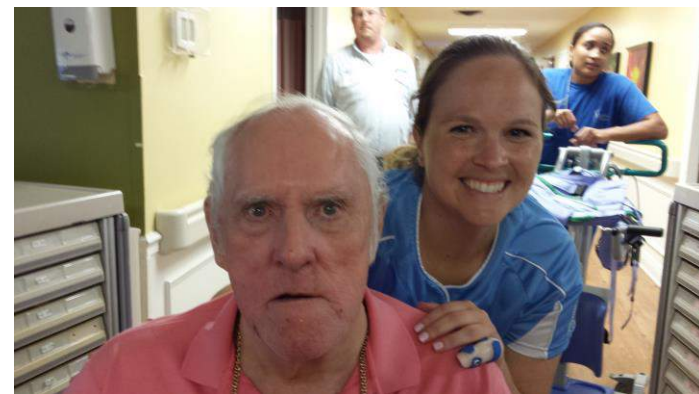
**Beginning in October
